

Elections Bulletin *

for the repeat election of the student council for the voting groups of the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences, the Faculty of Biological Sciences and the Faculty of Medicine of Friedrich Schiller University Jena in summer semester 2022

General

The student council (Studierendenrat) is part of the representation of interest of students at FSU Jena. Due to incorrect ballots, there will be a repeat election for the representatives of the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences, the Faculty of Biological Sciences and the Faculty of Medicine.

Electoral Procedure

The electoral procedure of the repeat election of the student council from **28th June till 05th July 2022, both 12 pm** is based on the Wahlordnung der Studierendenschaft from 27th January 2009 (version dated 7th January 2015). The election is general, equal, direct, free and secret. The repeat election, like the regular election, will be carried out as online elections with the option of postal ballot. It will be carried out based on candidate proposals with the principles of personalized proportional representation. For list election, seats will be distributed based on the Hare-Niemeyer method. If only single nominations (one person lists) are available or only one electoral list is available, election will be carried out on the principles of majority vote. Each voter possesses as many votes as seats are to be assigned in each voting group for the election of student council. Cumulative voting is possible for the election of student council. Polling is valid, if the will of the voter is clearly identifiable and not more votes were cast than seats are available for this council. The regularity of the process of election is audited by the election board of student community (Wahlvorstand der Studierendenschaft der FSU Jena). There is a separate bulletin for the voting groups and seat distribution.

Right to Vote

Every enrolled student who is listed in the original electoral register in the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences, the Faculty of Biological Sciences and the Faculty of Medicine possesses the active and passive right to vote. The assignment to the voting groups for the elections stands and is based on the first or main subject and as well as according to the changes of the voting group submitted and approved by the electoral board.

Election Proposals

The election proposals submitted for election, which are examined by the election committee, remain unchanged.

Election Process

The deadline for online voting starts on 28 June 2022, 12 pm, and ends on 5 July 2022, 12 pm. Voting in electronic form is also possible at the election office during regular opening hours.

The date and place of public enumeration of the postal vote will be announced.
